Make it attractive to come to the SPiN common room:

- 3 the Maria Montessori building. Since then, the XIVth and XVth boards have strived to make the
- 4 new SPiN common room known among members again, and to create an open and welcoming
- 5 space for psychology students. However, the XVth board has noticed that the room is mainly
- 6 visited by the same students, which are often former board members or students who have been
- 7 active within SPiN for an extended amount of time. Furthermore, the XVth board has heard from
- 8 students that there is a threshold to visit the SPiN common room if students do not know the
- 9 board well, and if there is not a specific reason to visit the common room (e.g., theme days).
- Nevertheless, the XVth board wishes for the SPiN room to be a welcoming place for all students,
- where students can openly associate with one another, and the board. The XVth board believes
- that this would add to the positive atmosphere within the association and the well-being of
- students, as moments of rest in between classes and frequent communication with other students
- are of significant importance for mental health. Therefore, the board would like to get your input
- and ideas on the following questions:
 - What attracts you to come to the SPiN common room? What keeps you from
- visiting the room?
- What do you think would help reduce the threshold to come to the SPiN common
- room?
