

## 1 REVISION OF GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

2 Dear General Members' Assembly,

3 The general terms and conditions of SPiN gives information to members on their rights and duties for  
4 membership application, contribution payment, and membership termination. Due to the  
5 implementation of the new website, the general terms and conditions have been subject to revision.  
6 The reason being that the terms and conditions include the mention of specific personal data which will  
7 no longer be applicable in the membership application on the new website.

8 The parts of the general terms and conditions that have been altered or added are highlighted in yellow.  
9 These changes include:

- 10 - The addition of revision information in the document, including a version number.
- 11 - The removal of a personal phone number being requested in the membership application form  
12 on the website.
- 13 - The addition of a signature being requested in the membership application form on the website.
- 14 - The referral to the GDPR, to give clarity on how personal data is being handled.

15 To implement these changes a vote will be held at the general members' assembly. The XVI<sup>th</sup> board  
16 hopes to have you properly informed of the revisions made in the general terms and conditions and  
17 welcomes any questions during the General Members' Assembly. Questions may also be sent to

## 22 STUDY ASSOCIATION PSYCHOLOGY IN NIJMEGEN (SPiN) CONTRIBUTION AND 23 PAYMENT TERMS AND CONDITIONS

24 Regarding the payment of contribution by the members of the Study association Psychology in  
25 Nijmegen (SPiN), filed at the Chamber of Commerce for Central Gelderland in Arnhem under  
26 number 09184577.

### 27 Article 1 General/definitions

- 28 - The association: the legal entity that is Study association Psychology in Nijmegen (SPiN), located in  
29 Nijmegen.
- 30 - Members: the natural persons who have applied for membership in accordance with the Articles of  
31 Association.
- 32 - Association year: the association year coincided with the financial year as defined in the By-laws and  
33 runs from October 1<sup>st</sup> to September 30<sup>th</sup>.

### 34 Article 2 Requesting membership

35 Paragraph 1. Membership requests must be submitted digitally or in writing to the Board and must  
36 contain the applicant's personal information (full name, date of birth, and address), bank account  
37 information, student number, e-mail address, **agreement to contribution deduction, and signature.**

38 Paragraph 2. The board may decide not to honour a membership request, as referred to in article 6  
39 of the Articles of Association.

### 40 Article 3 Personal information

41 Paragraph 1. The association reserves the right to use personal information for the purposes of its  
42 activities, **in accordance with the GDPR.**

43 Paragraph 2. Personal information will not be shared with third parties unless decided otherwise by  
44 the General Members Assembly. The board may only share personal information with a committee  
45 member if it is necessary for the performance of his or her duties.

### 46 Article 4 Contribution

47 Paragraph 1. Membership will be granted in accordance with the Articles of Association and the By-  
48 laws, and upon payment of an annual contribution, to be determined by the General Members  
49 Assembly no later than eight weeks before the end of the association year.

50 Paragraph 2. Members owe an annual contribution on the first day of the association year or on the  
51 day they registered as a member.

52 Paragraph 3. If membership is granted at a different point during the association year, the member  
53 is required to pay the full contribution for the entire year.

54 Paragraph 4. The contribution must be paid via direct debit on a date to be decided by the board.

55 **Article 5 Resignation and termination**

56 Paragraph 1. Membership can be terminated in the subsequent association year in accordance with  
57 the Articles of Association and the By-laws.

58 Paragraph 2. Association membership will be terminated by resignation, in accordance with article  
59 5.1.

60 Paragraph 3. Nevertheless, immediate termination of membership by resignation is possible within  
61 one month after a member was notified of an amendment to the contribution fees, pursuant to  
62 article 4.1 of this document.

63 Paragraph 4. The association may terminate membership immediately if a member remains in  
64 default despite repeated reminders. The member shall remain obliged to pay the contribution  
65 and/or fulfil other membership obligations.

66 Paragraph 5. A member who has resigned from the association is still obliged to meet the financial  
67 obligations arising from his or her membership or participation in association activities.

68 **Article 6 Payment defaults**

69 Paragraph 1. The association is entitled to charge the member for all judicial and extrajudicial costs  
70 incurred. These costs will be charged to the member as soon as they are in default and the matter  
71 has been handed over to a debt collection agency.

72 Paragraph 2. A declaration by the relevant lawyer, bailiff or collection agency will serve as proof of  
73 these extrajudicial costs.

74 Paragraph 3. In the event of non-payment, the association is entitled to suspend all products and  
75 services provided as part of membership, registration, or agreement with the association. The  
76 member will be eligible for all services after the contribution has been paid in full.

77 **Article 7 Applicable law**

78 Paragraph 1. Membership is governed by Dutch law.

79 Paragraph 2. This regulation must be adopted by the General Members Assembly at least two  
80 months before the end of the association year.

81 Paragraph 3. The Articles of Association and the By-laws of the Study association Psychology in  
82 Nijmegen should be consulted for all matters not referred to in these conditions.

83 Drawn up by the VI<sup>th</sup> Board of the Study Association Psychology in Nijmegen, revised by the XVI<sup>th</sup>  
84 Board, and adopted by the General Members' Assembly on 13-03-2024.

## 85 Other general terms and conditions

86 Concerning the registration of the memberships, it is required to record a number of data of our  
87 members. Together with name and address, these data are:

- 88 • Date of birth
- 89 • E-mail address
- 90 • Bank account number (IBAN) and BIC code
- 91 • Signature
- 92 • Student number

93 To look through your recorded data, you can ask the Secretary and file a motion to change, add or  
94 dismiss your data. Besides that, you can look through and change your personal data if you 'Log in'  
95 on the website.

### 96 *Way of use*

97 The Study association Psychology in Nijmegen (SPiN) uses the data for their own registration, the  
98 collection of the contribution and to communicate with the members.

99 Besides that, the data is used to request for subsidy and/or board grants at multiple organizations  
100 from the Radboud University. This applies in specific to the student number, which SPiN can use to  
101 request the status of the student at the Radboud University as a part of the request for subsidy  
102 and/or board grants.

103 By joining the Study association, I authorize SPiN to use my data as described above.
