

1 **Proposal code of conduct:**

2 SPiN strives to make her association a place that feels safe to not only her members, but to all
3 attending her activities. Over the past months, there have been multiple allegations made against
4 professors of the faculty of Social Sciences. With this came a social safety movement across the
5 university. SPiN was moved and realised that an implementation of a code of conduct could
6 encourage feelings of safety within the association. This code will highlight the behaviour that is
7 encouraged and appreciated at activities and list the behaviours that are deemed unacceptable.
8 This code is based on the code of conduct of SOFv, JFV, as well as the faculty of Social
9 Sciences, and is adapted to cater to SPiN and her members. It states that all SPiN members as
10 well as all attendees of SPiN events, must adhere to this code. If one does not adhere to this code,
11 then there will be a warning or a ban on attendance of activities. The XVIth board hopes that by
12 implementing this code, there will be an increased feeling of safety and wellbeing among SPiN's
13 members. Therefore, the board would like to get your input and ideas on the following questions:

- 14 - What makes you feel safe within SPiN and at activities?
- 15 - What makes you feel unsafe within SPiN and at activities?
- 16 - What are you missing within this piece?
